Prof. S.V. Sharma, Principal, RIE, Ajmer & Vice-Chairperson of the Management Committee commenced the meeting with welcome of Sh. Om Thanvi, Honourable Vice-Chancellor, MDS University, Ajmer & Chairperson Management Committee, Prof. Dinesh Saklani, Nominee of President NCERT, Prof. Pradeep Rao, Nominee of President NCERT, Prof. A.K. Srivastava, Nominee of Director NCERT, Prof. Subrato Dutta, Nominee of Vice-Chancellor, all the members and special invitees. Prof. S.V. Sharma, Principal RIE Ajmer placed the minutes of 59th meeting of Management Committee for confirmation followed by Action Taken Report before the house. The minutes were approved unanimously. Satisfaction was expressed by all the members on the activities of the Institute conducted during the last 5 years, brief report of the PAC programmes of 2020-21, other activities organized including deliberations and Lectures on National Education Policy 2020 during the year 2020-21 and Action Taken Report on minutes of the 59th Meeting of Management Committee. After this Prof. Sharma placed Programme Proposals for the year 2021-22 before the house.

During discussions on the programme proposals following suggestions emerged out:

Honourable Chairperson expressed satisfaction over the activities organized and efforts made by the Institute. He invited everyone in the meeting to share and express their views/suggestions. He also suggested to invite some eminent personalities from the field of literature, environment, culture, health and well being, Industry etc. for extension lecture series instead of only educationists. He insisted that we all should interact in local/regional/national language for better understanding and refined

presentations instead of any foreign language. He apprised the house that there is an emphasis in National Education Policy 2020 to promote mother tongue/local language for expression, teaching and learning. He suggested that the papers, presentations and proceedings of the seminars/conferences/webinars/extension lectures should be made available to the viewers on Institute website / YouTube Channel.

Prof. A.K. Srivastava, nominee of Director NCERT informed that NCERT has been given the responsibility to develop four National Curriculum Frameworks and twenty three working papers/position papers for implementing various recommendations of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. He said that there are number of things which have come to NCERT and RIEs. We all together have to focus on these responsibilities. NCERT has already prepared learning outcomes documents for elementary and secondary levels, now we have to finalise these outcomes for senior secondary level. Accordingly development of various resource materials for these learning outcomes need to be done. Prof. Srivastava pointed out that looking to the previous years' demand and expenditure ratio, the budgetary requirement mentioned in programme proposals remains on very higher side, it must be reduced to practicable level in the programme proposals proposed for the year 2021-22. Further he suggested to organize programmes pertaining to national conferences in the first half of the year and their outcomes/recommendations need to be communicated to the Council.

Prof. Dinesh Saklani, nominee of President NCERT i.e. Minister of Education, Government of India suggested to review the proposals proposed for the year 2021-22 in view of the recommendations of NEP 2020 and present pandemic situation. Accordingly, budgetary requirement need to be curtailed.

Prof. Pradeep Rao, nominee of President NCERT i.e. Minister of Education, Government of India appreciated the efforts of RIE Ajmer. He also suggested to invite some Institutions/agencies contributing exceptionally at national level to share their work and experiences in expression series programme.

Dr. Sarvendra Vikram Bahadur Singh, Director SCERT Lucknow, UP requested NCERT and RIE Ajmer to collaborate with SCERT Lucknow through the experts and for helping in improving and updating the skills of trainers of Uttar Pradesh State in the field of Language and Psychology.

Dr. Seema Jonsari, Director SCERT, Dehradun, Uttarakhand appreciated the efforts of RIE Ajmer and mentioned that all educational needs of the State have been included in the proposed programmes for the year 2021-22.





The meeting ended with a vote of thanks proposed to all by Prof. Rajesh Mishra, Dean of Instructions, RIE, Ajmer.
