#### Scholarships and Prizes

The NCERT has instituted a number of scholarships and prizes to encourage the students. All SC & ST candidates and the 50% of the remaining admitted students get scholarships state wise on merit cum means basis. Bhabha Prize is awarded to the students obtaining first position in B.Sc. B.Ed. programme, Vivekanand Prize to the topper of B.A. B.Ed. programme. Gopal Krishna Gokhale Prize is awarded to the topper of B.Ed. and Zakir Hussain Prize is awarded to the topper of M.Ed.

## Literary, Science, Cultural and Games & Sports Activities

The Students in pre-service programmes are divided into four Houses and House-wise competitions are held throughout the year to facilitate their all round growth and development. The activities organized include quiz, extempore, exhibition of TLM, model preparation, English and Hindi debates, essay writing (Hindi, English & Urdu), skit, music and dance, flower decoration, rangoli, indoor and outdoor games and sports competitions, annual athletic meet, etc.



#### **Facilities**

# Computer Lab

A well equipped Computer Laboratory functions as an asset of the institute. It has with all accessories like internet & Wi-Fi facilities for the use of students and staff. It has ICT facilities and Smart Boards and projectors. All these facilities strengthen the quality of education and e-cumminication for all the users.

#### Library

As a resource center in Northern Region, the Institute has a rich Library with more than 80,000 titles including thousands of non-print materials. There is also a vast reading room with separate reading corners for the staff and the research scholars. The library works under the open shelf system. It subscribes about 30 magazines, 29 foreign journals and 33 Indian journals, All foreign journals are available online and can be accessed through the LAN with the institute. On 51" year of NCERT foundation day, RIE Library launched Web OPAC for facilitating online search of library holdings. The Library remains open from 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m. on all working days.



#### Introduction

The Government of India established the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) in the year 1961 as an autonomous organization to assist and advise the central Government as well as the State Governments towards the implementation of their policies for education, especially to bring about qualitative changes in school education and teacher preparation. Consequently, four Regional Colleges of Education were established as constituent units of NCERT at Ajmer, Bhubaneswar, Bhopal & Mysore between the years 1963 and 1966. The North East Regional Institute of Education was set up at Shillong in 1995.

Regional College of Education, Ajmer was later renamed as Regional Institute of Education (RIE), Ajmer in 1995. The Foundation Stone was laid on 30<sup>th</sup> October, 1962 by Late Shri Kalulal Shrimali the then Education Minister, at the Govt of India. Regional Institute of Education, Ajmer caters to the educational needs of states/UTs of Northern Region (Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Delhi, Chandigarh, Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh). The Institute is expected to act as a leading Institution in the region and experiment with innovative integrated pre-service teacher education programmes to prepare quality teachers.

#### **Role Perception**

- As an advanced and pioneering Institute of education, it tries out innovative pre-service programmes and promotes research, develops instructional material and imparts training to In-service teachers.
- As a regional resource institution on school education and teacher education, it offers support system to the clientele states/UTs and disseminates information concerning improved methods, practices and patterns of education to the state/UT level agencies.
- As a regional centre of the NCERT, it advises the state/UT departments of education on policies and programmes related to all aspects of school education and extends help in the implementation of national level policies and programmes-originating from the MoE and the NCERT Headquarters.
- The Institute aims primarily at capacity building of the state and district level teacher education institutes like SCERTs, DIETs, IASEs, CTEs, etc. by undertaking specific projects in the areas of Research, Development and Training.

### Programmes

The Programmes of RIE Ajmer may be classified in the following areas:

#### 1. Programmes

The Institute offers the following Programmes:

- a) Four year integrated B.A. B.Ed. Programme.
- b) Four year Integrated B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme.
- c) Two year B.Ed. Programme
- d) Two year M.Ed. Programme.

In the above programmes, students are admitted through Common Entrance Examination (CEE).

 e) Diploma Course in Guidance and Counseling. In this course, students are admitted through written examination at institute level.

#### 2. Research

The Institute conducts research in the areas of curriculum development, curriculum analysis, teacher education, science education, environmental education, early child care education and other areas of regional and national importance.

#### 3. Extensions Services

Besides preparing teachers through pre-service programmes the institute performs the following extension activities to make teaching and learning effective in schools:

- Organizing need-based orientation programmes for strengthening the faculty members of DIETs, CTEs and IASEs on methods, content, Instructional aids, school management, curriculum development, textbook writing, elearning etc.
- b. Working as a monitoring and coordinating agency for the effective implementation of national schemes like Samagra Siksha Abhiyan, Rashtriya Avishkar Abhiyan (RAA), CCE etc. and improvement of Science and Mathematics Education, Alternative Education, Environmental Education, Population Education, Vocationalisation of Secondary Education and other central government sponsored schemes.
- C. Undertaking research projects in the areas like Value Education, Innovative Practices, Environmental Education, Population Education, Inclusive Education, Gender Inclusion, Science & Mathematics Education, Field testing of NCERT textbooks and offering feedback and providing consultancy to the Boards of Secondary Education in the Northern Region.
- d. Developing approaches, strategies and guidelines for teaching, preparing instructional material, training designs and packages in specific school subjects.
- Holding meetings and conferences with the State-level educational authorities with a view to find out obstacles in the way of improving the quality of School Education and the ways of overcoming them.
- Organizing expression series on eminent personalities and extension lectures of eminent educationists, scientists and social reformers of National & International repute.

#### Departments

To facilitate the execution of various activities, the following five departments have been constituted in the institute:

#### 1. Department of Education (DE)

Besides the core component of Education, the Department manages Educational Technology, Education of Groups with Special needs, Physical Education, Population Education and Computer Education. The Department also has a well equipped Psychology Laboratory.

The Institute has fully equipped studio to produce high quality video/web/multimedia based instructional material to use at various platform like PM e-vidya, Kishore Manch etc. The Institute also has e-learning centre for the use of students and trainees of various programmes of NCERT/RIE.

# Department of Education In Science and Mathematics (DESM)

The Department consists of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany and Zoology sections. All the Sections have well equipped laboratories. The technology section with its Electrical Lab and Wood Workshop functions as a service department besides engaging the work experience classes. An Innovation Hub has been established in the department. Environmental Education Theme Park is also functioning in the campus to promote environmental awareness through interactive way and to bring school children, youth and teachers to a forum where they can discuss their perspectives on the environmental issues. The Theme Park is instrumental in strengthening school education programmes and training of school children for generating environmental awareness.



#### Department of education in Social Sciences and Humanities (DESSH)

The Department comprises of English, Hindi, Urdu and Social Sciences Sections. Geography & Language Laboratories function under this department.

#### 4. Department of Extension Education (DEE):



The Department has the responsibility of looking after different extension programmes pertaining to research, development of Instructional material and training. It also has the responsibility of dissemination and clearing house function.

#### 5. Demonstration Multipurpose School (DMS)

The DM School was established in 1964 as a pace setting institution. It also serves as RIEs laboratory for conducting educational experiments and trying out innovations in the teaching learning process. It is a co-educational school and follows the three language formula. It is affiliated to the CBSE and provides education to students from pre-primary to Senior Secondary level. At the Senior Secondary level, students have the options of Humanities, Science, Commerce and Vocational Streams. The School has separate primary and pre-primary Sections. The School has its separate library, well equipped laboratories, computer Labs and other necessary physical facilities. The School library has a collection of about 30,000 books, newspapers (Hindi, English) and above 100 Multimedia CD/DVD Collections. Library subscribes 37 magazines every year.
