Guidelines for Submission of Abstracts and Papers

- Research papers and presentations will be accepted in all three languages i.e. **English, Hindi and Urdu** as medium of presentation subject to the languages concerned.
- Please follow the guidelines for the **format** and **typing details** as mentioned below:
(i) Format: Papers in English, Hindi and Urdu will only be accepted in M.S. Word format.
(ii) Fonts: Please follow the guidelines below while using fonts for different languages/mediums:
For papers in English: Research papers in English must be typed in Times New Roman font, in 12 font size for regular text and 14 font size for titles with Double spacing.
For papers in Hindi: Research papers in Hindi must be typed in Kruti Dev010 font or DevLys010 font, in 16 font size for regular text and 18 font size (bold) for titles with Double spacing.
For papers in Urdu: Research papers in Urdu must be typed in Jameel Noori Nastaleeq font in 14 font size for regular text and 16 font size (bold) for titles with Double spacing.

- The maximum word limit of paper will be 2500 words, including abstract in 250 -300 words. Abstract followed by keywords is essential. Latest MLA stylesheet to be used for all citations in literature/language papers. All ELT papers should have citation in APA Stylesheet. Papers in Hindi as well as in Urdu should also follow appropriate guidelines for citation and references.
- Authors may put their names only at the right margin of the page below the main title and affiliation details with email and contact number at the end of the paper.
- Accepted full papers have to be submitted at the earliest as the published proceedings will be released in the inaugural session of the conference.
- The abstract and paper along with registration form should be submitted in the form of softcopy only at e-mail: nclerieajmer@gmail.com by the due dates as mentioned above.
- Kindly mention the title and the sub-themes (Mandatory) of your paper in the Registration Form.

TA and Accommodation

Location

Ajmer is well-known all over India as a historical and religious place of pilgrimage as well as an educational hub. It owes this reputation partly due to the Regional Institute of Education. The Institute is situated about 6 km away from Ajmer Railway Station in the midst of idyllic surroundings with the historic Anasagar Lake in front and the Aravali Hills all around. It is almost equidistant from the world famous Dargah of Khawaja Moinuddin Chisti and Teerthraj Pushkar. The distance of the Institute from the city bus stand is about 6 km. Auto and Taxi services are available from both the places (Railway Station and Bus Stand). Ajmer city is well connected with the trains from major cities of the country.
