**A Brief Report on Plantation Drive**

In view of Notice F.No.1/RIE/IQAC/2017-18/2787-2812 dated 13-8-2018, a plantation drive was organized in the Regional Institute of Education, Ajmer immediately after the celebration of Independence Day on 15-8-2018. Students and staff members of the Institute participated actively in it and about hundred different plants such as Neem (*Azadirachta indica*), Kadam (*Neolamarckia cadamba*), Amaltash (*Cassia fistula*), Gulmohar (*Delonics stagia*), Arjun (*Terminalia arjuna*), Amala (*Phyllanthus emblica*), Harshringar (*Nictanthes arbor tristis*), Khejri (*Prossopis cerneraria*), Sahjana (*Moringe oleifera*), Bargad (*Ficus benghalensis*), Piple (*Ficus religiosa*) and Gular (*Ficus racemosa*) were planted to make the campus green and sensitized the students about the importance of plantation and different issues and concerns of environment. Faculty members of the Institute and DMS highlighted the concerns and issues pertaining to environment conservation. Also they have made their focus on the role of plantation in improving and attracting the migratory bird status in the campus. Plantation drive was inaugurated by the Principal Prof. G.
