## Introduction

The National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) is an autonomous organization set up in 1961 by the Government of India to assist and advise the Central and State Governments on Policies and programmes for qualitative improvement in school education. The Regional Institutes of Education located in the different regions of the country are major constituent units of NCERT. One of the major objectives of the NCERT and its constituent units is to organize pre-service and in-service training of teachers and teacher trainees and to develop and disseminate innovative educational techniques and practices.

The *Regional Institute of Education, Ajmer* was set up in 1963. It caters to the educational needs of the northern region of the country comprising the States of Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Delhi and the UT of Chandigarh. Programmes offered in RIE Ajmer are affiliated to Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati (MDS) University, Ajmer and recognized by the NCTE. Admission to B.Sc. B.Ed programme of RIE Ajmer is restricted to candidates having domicile in the States of Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh and the UT of Delhi and Chandigarh (For details see website of RIE Ajmer). The number of the seats available in RIE, Ajmer for admission to B.Sc. B.Ed. programme is 100; 50 for Physical Science Group and 50 for Biological Science Group.

The *Regional Institute of Education, Bhubaneswar* caters to the educational needs of the eastern region of the country comprising the States of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Jharkhand, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Odisha, Sikkim, Tripura, West Bengal and the UT of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Programmes offered in RIE Bhubaneswar are affiliated to Utkal University, Bhubaneswar and recognized by the NCTE. Admission to B.Sc. B.Ed programme of RIE is restricted to candidates having domicile in the states of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Jharkhand, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Odisha, Sikkim, Tripura, West Bengal and the UT of Andman and Nicobar Islands.(For details see website of RIE, Bhubaneswar). The number of seats available in RIE, Bhubaneswar for admission to B.Sc. B.Ed. programme is 100; 50 for Physical Science Group and 50 for Biological Science Group.

The *Regional Institute of Education, Bhopal* caters to the educational needs of the western region of the country comprising of the States of Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Goa and the UT of Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli. Programmes offered in RIE Bhopal are affiliated to Barkatullah University, Bhopal. Admission to B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme of RIE is restricted to candidates having domicile in the States of

Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Goa and the UT of Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli. (For details see website of RIE Bhopal) The number of seats available in RIE Bhopal for admission to B.Sc B.Ed programme is 80; 40 for Physical Science Group and 40 for Biological Science Group.

The *Regional Institute of Education, Mysore* caters to the educational needs of the southern region of the country comprising the States of Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Telangana, Tamil Nadu and the UT of Puducherry and Lakshadweep. Programmes offered in RIE Mysore are affiliated to the University of Mysore. Admission to B.Sc.Ed. Programme of RIE is restricted to candidates having domicile in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Telagana, Tamil Nadu, the UT of Puducherry and Lakshadweep. (For details visit [RIE Mysore](#)) The number of the seats available in RIE Mysore for admission to B.Sc Ed. Programme is 60; 30 for Physical Science Group and 30 for Biological Science Group.

The *North East Regional Institute of Education (NERIE), Shillong* is a constituent unit of National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT), New Delhi. NERIE was set up at Shillong in 1995 to cater to the educational needs of the North Eastern states, viz., Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura. NERIE aspires to provide academic and technical support system to assist and advise the governments of the above mentioned states on policies and programmes on all aspects of school education and reshape the State curricula. It primarily aims at capacity building of the state and district level resource institutions/teachers education institutions and State Boards of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education located in the region in undertaking research, development and training. It is affiliated to North Eastern Hill University (NEHU), Shillong. NERIE is offering Two-year B.Ed. (Secondary) Course from August 2015 for the students drawn from the North East Region. The course is a fulltime, regular course and approved by NCTE (Please see NCTE website:[www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org)). The course has already been offered by other RIEs for the past several years and it has been well established and well received across the country. The course is a blend of theory and engagement with the field (practicum) in keeping with the NCTE guidelines.

### **About The Course**

#### **B.Sc.B.Ed. /B.Sc.Ed.**

The B.Sc.B.Ed. /B.Sc.Ed. Course is a professional course and it aims at producing competent teachers of science and mathematics teaching at

secondary level. This is an innovative teacher education course. It provides training in methodology along with instruction in various content areas. The four year integrated course has been designed in view of the latest researches and experiments in the field of education. Besides having latest knowledge in content areas the teacher trainees become well versed in pedagogy and communication skills which are integrated throughout the duration of the course. The B.Sc. B.Ed./B.Sc. Ed. course (4yr) has been one the most prestigious courses offered by the RIEs of NCERT, New Delhi. Our candidates were selected for regular job of teachers on the basis of campus interviews by Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, Delhi Public School and other reputed schools of the country. Through CEE-2015 candidates will get opportunity to get admission in B.Sc. B.Ed. in any of RIE Ajmer, Bhubaneswar, Bhopal, Mysore based on state of eligibility.

### **Eligibility**

#### **B.Sc.B.Ed./ B.Sc.Ed. Course**

- Candidates seeking admission to Physical Science Group must have passed with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics (PCM)

(Mathematics includes Mathematics or Statistics) and those seeking admission to Biological Science Group (CBZ) must have passed Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB) (Biology includes Biology or Biotechnology) at +2 level.

- Candidates must have passed +2 / Hr. Sec./ Sr. Sec. or any equivalent examination recognised by University/ Board with at least 60% marks in aggregate of subjects of combination of the group they are applying for (relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ ST/PH candidates). The examination should be recognised by the affiliated universities of the RIEs.
- Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination up to two years back i.e., 2013, 2014 and appearing/ appeared in 2015 can apply.

### **Reservation of Seats**

As per the Government of India rules candidates belonging to certain categories are admitted to seats reserved for them based on relaxed criteria. The following reservations are available SC 15%, ST 7.5%, OBC 27%, PH 3% Candidates applying under reservation quota will be considered only on the basis of the lists notified by the Government of India and the category certificate/ PH certificate in the format approved by the GOI and issued by the competent authority. OBC candidates will have to attach a certificate from competent authority stating that he/ she does not belong to creamy layer.

### **Hostel**

Separate hostel facilities for boys and girls are available on each RIE campus.

### **Other General Information**

The candidates are expected to fill the form online. Please refer to how to apply on the portal for complete step by step information. The candidates

have to download the admit card by using this registration number from online application system web link. The candidates for common entrance examination have the option to apply online only. The fee for application is Rs. 800/- for General and OBC and Rs. 400/- for SC/ ST/ PH candidates. For online submission of application form visit websites [www.rieajmer.ac.in](http://www.rieajmer.ac.in) or [www.ncert.nic.in](http://www.ncert.nic.in) and follow the instructions carefully. The applicants must note that after submission of the application form it cannot be withdrawn. Claims for refund of application fee will not be entertained. For filling and submitting the application form please go through the following general information.

Ensure that you fulfill all the eligibility criteria for the admission to B.Sc. B.Ed./B.Sc. Ed./ B.A. B.Ed./ B.A. Ed./ B.Ed. (Two Year)/ M.Sc. Ed. courses.

Application form must be completed in all respects. Incomplete application form will be outrightly rejected and there will be no further correspondence in this regard.

Option once selected in the application form cannot be changed later.

The application fee is non refundable.

The application form duly completed in all respects, after printing the hard copy of filled application form(s), it should reach to the address printed with application form(s) by 12th May, 2015.

No written acknowledgment will be given for the receipt of the application. However, the candidate can verify application status on RIE, Ajmer website [www.rieajmer.ac.in](http://www.rieajmer.ac.in)

If you are visually impaired and unable to read question papers in normal printed size font even with corrective spectacles/lenses and require question papers with enlarged font or require an amanuensis (scribe) then select the appropriate check box available during the filling of application form.

Year of passing / appearing qualifying examination should be selected.

For Date of Birth, enter the date, month and year of your birth as per the English calendar and as recorded in your 10th certificate using 01 to

31 for date and 01 to 12 (January to December) for month and the four digits for the year.

You have been given list of the centres and their corresponding codes where the centre for the common entrance examination will be located. Select any three city codes from the list. Your first preference must be entered first, then second and thereafter third.

During the common entrance examination bilingual (English/Hindi) question paper will be provided.

Write the complete postal address. The address must include your name, c/o name and full address with PIN code. Write your mobile no. also through which messages can be sent or contacted if required. E-mail address must be written clearly using small letters.

Your recent colour photograph should be affixed in the given box.

Please read the disclaimer given on printed form carefully. By signing the form candidate abides with the declaration. Please note that this signature will appear in your admit card and will be verified during the examination.

Candidates after depositing examination fee, have to generate the e-receipt (from payment history at State Bank Collect) and SBCollect Reference Number will be used during registration process.

### **State/UT of Domicile**

Select the appropriate State /UT against which you are seeking admission. As a proof of eligibility of State/ UT for admission the candidate has to produce any one of the following documents :

Evidence of having passed the qualifying examination from the State/ UT as given in the advertisement.

In case of legal guardian / parents is an employee of State/ Central Govt. / Govt. of India undertaking/ Autonomous bodies the latest certificate of place of posting in the State/ UT

A domicile certificate from the competent authority.

Candidates need to fill any one of the choices (a) , (b) or (c).

### **Admit Card**

The admit card will bear the name, photograph, roll number, signature, date of birth, address, category of the candidate, along with the name and address of the examination centre allotted. The admit card can be downloaded from the same online application system web link by using their initial registration number. The candidate will have to bring admit card to the examination centre. Only those candidates who will be holding admit cards will be allowed to appear in the examination.

### **Areas for Common Entrance Examination**

Separate Questions will be prepared for the following two groups:

**1. Group-A**

B.Sc. B.Ed./B.Sc.Ed./B.A.B.Ed./B.A. Ed. / M.Sc.Ed. (Mysore)

**2. Group-B**

Two Year B.Ed.

3. For both the groups, areas to be tested: Language Proficiency, Teaching Aptitude/Attitude, and Reasoning Ability.
4. Out of 80 questions, Language Proficiency in English 20 questions, Teaching Aptitude/Attitude 30 questions and Reasoning Ability 30 questions weightage will be given.
5. Medium of Test Booklets – only in English and Hindi.
6. **The student's need to clear minimum cut off marks in all three test areas.**  
: **Correct answer(s) will carry 2 marks each**  
: **Wrong answer(s) will carry negative marking of (minus) -0.5 marks each and**  
: **Question(s) unattended will carry no marks**
7. No. of test items-80, Time Duration-120 minutes.
8. No. of test booklets-Only one set of booklet will be prepared for each group.

9. Last date for submission of marks (20% of weightage) by the candidate is 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2015.
1. **Group-A** test items will be of +2 level,
2. **Group-B** test items will be of graduate level.

## **Results of Common Entrance Examination & Ranking**

1. Scoring will be done with 80% from entrance examination and 20% from following definitions of aggregate scores for B.Sc. B.Ed./ B.Sc. Ed./ B.A. B.Ed./ B.A. Ed. and M.Sc. Ed.. For two year B.Ed. only entrance examination score will be utilized.
2. Aggregate score will be defined as:
  - a. For B.Sc. B.Ed./ B.Sc. Ed. /M.Sc. Ed. aggregate score of subjects of combination i.e., PCM or PCB/Maximum marks of subjects of combinations
  - b. For B.A. B.Ed./ B.A. Ed. obtained total marks of qualifying examination/ Maximum marks of subject of combinations
3. A candidate can apply for more than one course/ programme for admission with a single registration with a single payment.

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination up to two years back i.e., 2013, 2014 and appearing/ appeared in 2015 can apply B.Sc. B.Ed./ B.Sc. Ed./ B.A. B.Ed./ B.A. Ed. / M.Sc. Ed. There is no restriction in the passing year to apply in Two year B.Ed. In tie-up cases in various rank lists adopted for awarding ranks to the candidates who have scored the same marks will be preferred on following basis :

## **Counselling and Admission**

The Counselling and admission will be done in respective RIEs. The details of the counselling and admission procedures and dates will be available on the websites of concerned RIEs. For availability of number of seats for State/UTs please contact to RIE concerned.

## **Scholarships**

All SC,ST and 50% of remaining students will be awarded scholarships as per NCERT rules on submission of parent's income certificate. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of merit list of admission. Staying in hostel is compulsory for Scholarship holders.
